## Solution

To change this configuration, you need to go to Jira Administration >> Manage apps >> Xray >> Custom Fields and in Requirement Status Custom Field Versions and select the desired option:

- Requirement Status Custom Field Versions

When this option is enabled, the status of each Test associated with the Requirement is calculated based in the latest TestRun independently on the ver
  - ☒ Earliest Unreleased Version  
When this option is enabled, only the earliest unreleased Fix Version is displayed in the Custom Field.
  - ☐ Unreleased Versions  
When this option is enabled, all unreleased Fix Versions are displayed in the Custom Field.
  - ☐ Assigned Versions  
When this option is enabled, all explicitly assigned Fix Versions are displayed in the Custom Field.
