As a Jira administrator, you can create additional Test Step statuses. These statuses are applied to Test Step results. Each status can have a name, description, have a specific color and a Test Run Status.

If you delete a status and there are Test Step results in this particular status, then you'll be prompted for a migration status field to update the affected Test Steps.

Native Test Step statuses can't be modified nor deleted.

Create a custom Test Step Status

New Test Step statuses can be created and all existing custom statuses can be modified.

To create a new custom status, go to the Add New Test Step Status section at the bottom of the page, fill out the following fields, and press Add":

- Name: the name of the custom status, with the following syntax: ^[a-zA-Z0-9_-/]{2,18}\$
- Description: the description for the custom status
- Color: the color for the new custom status.
- Test Status: the Test Status to map this step status when calculating coverage.
