Single operations

Create a global Test Environment

To create a new local Test Environment, click on **Create Environment**, fill out the following fields and then press **Save**:

- **Name:** the name for the Test Environment (a string of 2 up to 18 non-space characters)
- **Description:** the description for the Test Environment
- **URL:** the URL of the Test Environment

Modify a global Test Environment

Some fields of an existing Test Environment can be modified (except the name). You just to need to:

- 1. Click **Edit** on the table entry corresponding to the Test Environment.
