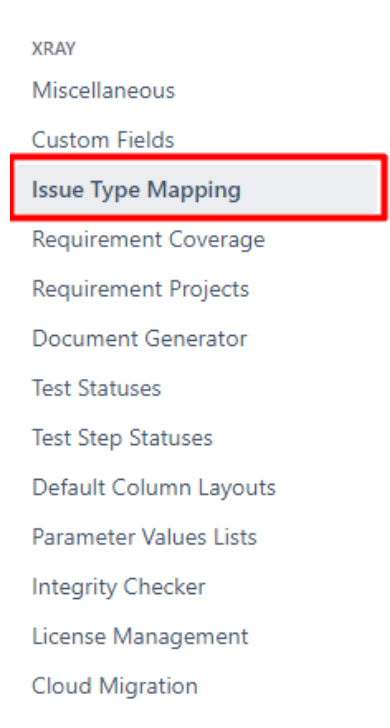
Solution

You need to configure your issue type as a Requirement in the Xray settings:

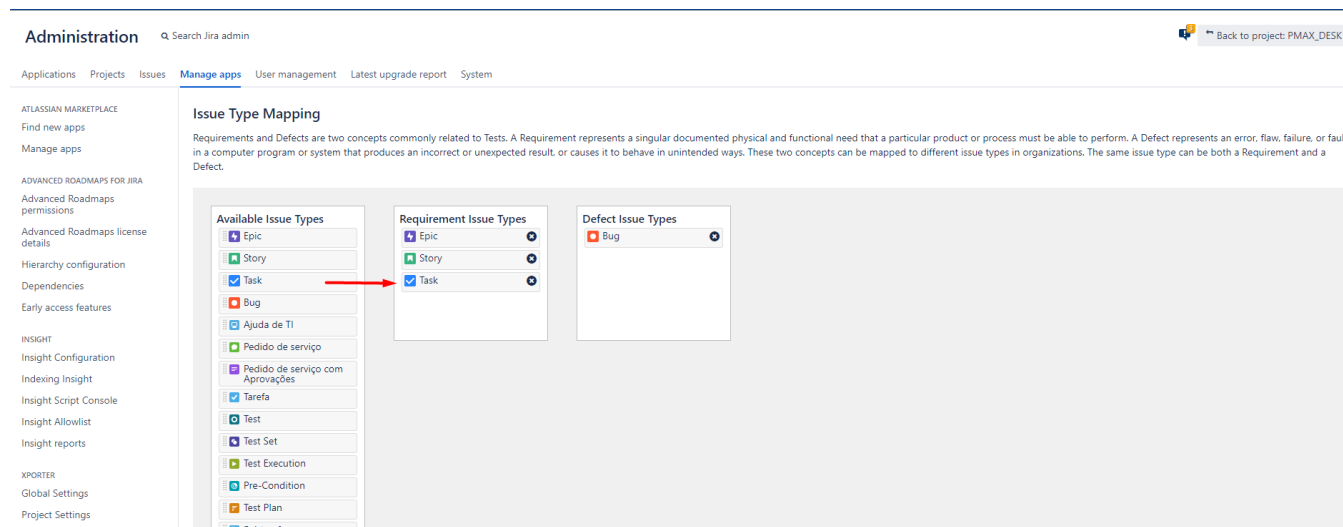
- 1 - Go to Jira Administration
