Exporting from a single Test

When Xporter is enabled for a project, the Xporter section will appear on the right side of the Test page. To export the Test, just select the desired template from the drop-down box and click **Export**.

Exporting from a Bulk of Tests

Exporting multiple Tests is achieved using the Bulk Change operations.

Step 1 - Select the Tests that you want to export using a [search filter](#) and selecting **Bulk Change**.
